

COLLEGE-LEVEL EXAMINATION PROGRAM (CLEP)

Rappahannock Community College awards credit for the successful completion of the following CLEP exams. CLEP was established to enable individuals who have acquired education in non-traditional ways to demonstrate academic achievement. The minimum credit-granting score will be the American Council of Education's (ACE) recommendation at the time the test was administered.

Credit will be awarded after an official copy of the CLEP score report has been received by the admissions and records office and the score report has been evaluated. It takes approximately 2 weeks for the evaluation process once the score report is received at RCC.
