

Panopto Automated Captioning

The Americans with Disabilities Act has implications for our videos, as best practice all should be captioned. Videos available on a public web page must be captioned when made available. Ones only in Blackboard can wait a bit longer but must be able to be captioned very quickly.

Automated Captioning is an excellent start—while it may or may not fill all the requirements it will shorten the time need to create captions.

- 1) Access Panopto and find your video—Hover over the title to see the Menu—Click **Settings**.
- 2) On the Settings page, click on **Search**.
- 3) In the Speech area, Click **Process**.
This will process the video with the Panopto Speech Recognition engine. This will take several minutes to complete. There will be no notification.
- 4) Click **Overview** to go back to main Settings page.
Under *Actions* title, Click **Edit** (may need to scroll down).
****See Special Note Below**
- 5) In the Upper Left of the Edit window, click **Captions**
- 6) Click the **Import Captions** drop down
- 7) Click **Import Automatic Captions**
- 8) Captions will display.
***Note:** This system is not going to be 100% accurate. You may wish to review and edit the captions.
- 9) To edit captions, click on the one you wish to edit and make changes. Click away on the screen, captions will be automatically saved.

Special Note: For Older recordings you may receive notification that you need to edit in the Advanced Editor. Here it will be necessary to Reprocess the Video.

- a) On **Settings** page, go to **Manage**
- b) Under *Processing Management* click **Re-process**.
- c) You will receive an email when this is done. Now you may pick up with step #4 above.
