

Enabling Panopto Video Downloads

You will need to configure a Download link:

1. Record your video as normal and wait until you receive your Panopto email
2. Post the *View* link it gives you in the email. That will use the streaming page – best for tablets and folks on campus or who have fast internet.

"Recording PowerPoint in Panopto" is now ready to view.

3. Look nearer the bottom, the last link is titled *Additional Output Formats*.
4. Click that link, it will take you to our Panopto Website, log in with your username and Password (same as with the recorder)
5. You will be presented with the Outputs page for your video, go to the second section – **Video Podcast** – there is a link titled *Download Podcast*.



6. Right-Click on **Download Podcast**, then click **Copy Link Location** on the pop-up menu
7. Go to your Blackboard course, and along with your View link post the Download link (Best Practice is to label it as Download Video or similar)
8. Don't forget to click **Submit** in Blackboard
