

## RCC Equivalents for IB Exams

Rappahannock Community College awards credit for the successful completion of the following International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. This program allows students to pursue college-level studies while still in secondary schools. An IB score of “4 or higher” is required for transfer credit from a Higher Level (HL) IB course, and an IB score of “5 or higher” is required for transfer credit from a Standard Level (SL) IB course.

Students must be pursuing a degree or certificate at RCC in order to receive transfer credit. Credit will be awarded after an official copy of the IB score report has been received by the admissions and records office, and the score report has been evaluated. It takes approximately 2 weeks for the evaluation process once the score report is received at RCC.
